**ROLFE LANE & CRAYTHORNE LANE,  
NEW ROMNEY**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2019**

To allow works to be carried out to construct a new footway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Rolfe Lane and Craythorne Lane, New Romney.

A closure is planned from Monday 12 August 2019 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Rolfe Lane and Craythorne Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction where they meet each other, as indicated on site.

The alternative routes are

*Rolfe Lane* via Ashford Road and Cockreed Lane

*Craythorne Lane* via Fairfield Road, Ashford Road and Rolfe Lane

Local access to the remainder of each road continues from either direction up to where the roads are closed.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.
