VARIOUS TOWN CENTRE ROADS, FAVERSHAM

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that the roads listed below will be closed to through traffic, on 15th June 2020 between the times 1000hrs to 1600hrs for a period of up to 21 days.

Court Street, Faversham – From the junction with Market Place to the junction with Crescent Road.

Market Place, Faversham – For its entire length.

Middle Row, Faversham – For its entire length.

West Street, Faversham – From the junction with Market Place to a point in line with the boundary of 121 and 122 West Street.

These temporary restrictions will be in operation in conjunction with the existing 1000hrs to 1600hrs permanent traffic restrictions already in place on these roads. However, this notice will temporarily suspend the disabled and loading exceptions to ensure there is no vehicle access on the above roads during the restricted times.


There are no alternative routes available.

These restrictions are necessary to enable Faversham Town Council to put in place various social distancing measures to assist in the reopening of Faversham Town Centre following the Covid-19 lockdown.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
