



## The County of Dorset (Various Roads, North Dorset) (20mph, 30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) (No. ' ) Order 201'

Dorset County Council proposes to make an Order under relevant Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to amend speed limits on the A350 and C13 (and some side roads as listed below).

The affected roads are as follows:

- A350, Iwerne Minster
- A350, Stourpaine
- A350, Sutton Waldron
- A350, Cann
- A350, Compton Abbas
- A350, Fontmell Magna
- B3081, Cann Common
- C13, Higher Shaftesbury Road/Boyne's Lane/Spread Eagle Hill
- C13, Melbury Abbas
- C13, Melbury Street/Dinah's Hollow, Melbury Abbas
- C13, Spread Eagle Hill
- Boundary Road leading to Compton Abbas Airfield
- Church Lane, Sutton Waldron
- Unnamed Road leading to Everley Farm, Iwerne Steepleton.
- French Hill Lane, West Melbury
- Napiers Way, Sutton Waldron
- Quarry Lane, West Melbury
- Sutton Hill, Sutton Waldron
- The Street, Sutton Waldron
- Unnamed road leading to Gourds Farm Barn, North of Compton Abbas
- West Lane, West Melbury
